

The Extreme Mustang Makeover Youth Incentive Fund

Purpose:

The Extreme Mustang Makeover Youth Incentive Fund provides limited financial assistance for selected Youth Trainers participating in Extreme Mustang Makeover events. Created by Melia Gore, a 12 year old first time competitor in the 2015 EMM Fort Worth, who offered to give back \$1000 (50%) of her earnings to help create an incentive fund to assist other youth in offsetting the costs of training the mustangs. Through the EMM Youth Incentive Fund, youth mustang trainers may apply for funds to assist in expenses related to caring for their competitive mustang. Selection will be based on the Youth Trainer's application, financial needs and ownership plans. Grants will not be awarded to everyone that applies, there will be one (1) grant rewarded per event.

Application Rules:

1. Youth Trainers that have applied and been accepted to participate in the Extreme Mustang Makeover Youth events will be considered for financial assistance through the Extreme Mustang Makeover Youth Incentive Fund.
2. Youth Trainers must have passing grades in school.
3. Youth Trainers must blog or Facebook their training progress.
4. Youth Trainers must perform one public speaking event or demonstration with their mustang in training. (Youtube video acceptable)
5. Youth Trainers are not required to, but asked to either donate a percentage of their earnings back to the Youth Incentive Fund, or attempt to raise money for the Fund, which is sourced solely from donations.
6. Youth Trainers must apply for Youth Incentive Fund by the same competition application deadline of the event they are competing in.
7. A three member committee will review applications and make selections. Committee members will remain anonymous.
8. Grants will be \$250 per Youth Trainer and be determined by committee.
9. Payment of funds will be made directly to the Youth Trainer, parent or adopter within 14 days after mustang pickup.
10. Youth Trainers may only receive one grant annually.
